CYGNET PROGRAMME FEEDBACK SHOW REAL BENEFITS

Parents and carers have fed back positively to us about the Cygnet Programme, which is a course delivered by Swindon Educational Psychology Service for parents and carers of children and young people aged 5-18 who have received a diagnosis of Autistic Spectrum Condition (ASC).

The feedback from parents and carers highlighted that 84% of attendees who attended the two courses, that where run in 2019, found the topics in the session helpful. Also, 79% found the information and practical suggestions given throughout the course helpful in terms of understanding and managing their child or young person's behaviour.

Below are some of the comments from parents and carers who attended the course which highlights the impact of the course:

"Sharing and applying psychology helps understand and support behaviour change"

"I understand my child better. I see things now which I previously dismissed"

"It helps to look deeper and have more understanding"

"Knowing that you are not alone"
