The personal information that SAM may keep for the LDPB could be your

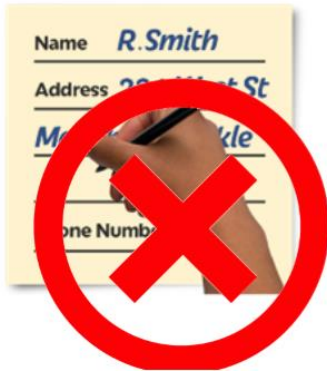
- Name

SAM keeps your personal information safe and will not share it with anybody else



SAM will keep the information for as long as the LDPB keeps running or until you ask them to remove it
